BRIDGE COLLAPSE CASE

Police move Morbi district court for further remand of 2 accused

AFTER A magisterial court refused to grant further police remand of two accused officials in the Morbi suspension bridge collapse case, police have filed a revision application with the Morbi district court.

The application seeking five more days of remand of the accused officials was listed before the court of principal district and sessions judge PC Joshi on Wednesday and was adjourned. It is now expected to be taken up on November 11.

On November 5, a magisterial court had refused to grant further police remand of Deepak Parekh and Dinesh Mahasukhray Dave — two accused managers of Orevia, the firm that used to manage the bridge that collapsed. The two were in police custody for four days.

Meanwhile, another accused Prakashbhai Laljibhai Parmar (63) moved a bail plea before the district court. Prakashbhai and his son Devangbhai are proprietors of a Surendranagar-based firm called Dev Prakash Fabrication. The remaining eight accused have not filed any bail plea yet. All nine arrested are in judicial custody.

According to police, the firm was sub-contracted by Orevia company to undertake the restoration of the suspension bridge, which collapsed on October 30, killing 135 persons, including 55 children. On November 1, two of the accused submitted before a magisterial court that they were only involved in completing the job works assigned to them such as welding, electric fitting, etc.

According to the police, a contract was signed between Orevia and Dev Prakash Fabrications for bridge repair work at Rs 29 lakh, with no specifications on SOP or the works that were to be completed.

On Wednesday, a police official said that the investigation authorities received documents pertaining to the agreement between the Morbi municipality and Orevia company as well as those pertaining to the bridge restoration project, while it was yet to receive the requested documents from Rajkot



and Morbi collectorates.

A senior official said that the forensic report from FSL was expected in a week. On November 5, FSL Gandhinagar had collected "truckload samples" of the bridge.

A senior police officer said Orevia owner Jaysukh Patel is "not traceable as of now".

Meanwhile, a second public interest litigation was filed at the Gujarat High Court by Surat-based "social activist" Sajeev alias Sanjay Bhargav Ezhava, seeking the court's directions for a magisterial inquiry through an independent agency such as the NIA.

Earlier, a PIL was filed by a Vadodara-based lawyer. On November 7, the Gujarat HC called for status report from state government authorities and State Human Rights Commission after instituting a PIL, taking suo motu cognisance of news reports.

The petitioner also sought that the five-member SIT formed by the state government be recalled and that the government authorities along with Ajanta Manufacturing Pvt Limited be directed to pay Rs 25 lakh compensation to kin of the deceased and Rs 5 lakh compensation for those who suffered serious injuries.

The PIL also said that in previous such incidents also, "government appointed committees but nothing fruitful has been done thereafter".

HC refuses to withdraw prosecution against BJP MLA: 'Prosecutor puppet in govt's hand'

THE GUJARAT High Court Wednesday refused to permit the withdrawal of prosecution against BJP MLA from Jamkhambalia Dharmendrasinh alias Hakuba Jadeja in a case of unlawful assembly, stone pelting and rioting dating back to 2007.

The court, in its order, observed that "anyhow and at any cost, the state government is trying to save his sitting MLA... under the pretext of public interest," and termed the special public prosecutor a "puppet" for "acting only on the direction of the higher authorities".

Special public prosecutor Kamleshkumar Dave, handling the trial of the case before a magistrate court, had approached the HC in July seeking withdrawal of prosecution in the case against 46

persons, including the MLA.

Observing that such an application is non-maintainable, the court noted in its verdict, "...the said learned Special Public Prosecutor is nothing but a sheer 'puppet' in the hands of the state government who has not kept his obligation towards the court and only with a view to please the superior authority, made such an application".

"The said application appears to have been filed not in a good faith, in the interest of public policy and justice. Rather, it appears to have been filed purely with a political interest," it added.

The court of Justice Niral Mehta, while rejecting the plea, noted that the court "could not find as to how withdrawal of criminal case would advance the cause of justice" and "how the withdrawal from prosecution would sub-serve the public interest."

The court further observed

that if the accused would not have been the political leader, such an application for withdrawal of prosecution would not have been filed.

In December 2007, a mob of around 300 persons had gathered outside the gate of Essar company at Khambhalia taluka for public agitation for the resolution of issues affecting public at large and local agriculturists, and during the said agitation, the mob had started stone pelting on the buses of the company resulting in injuries to employees travelling in the buses.

Police officers who were deployed there to maintain public peace and safety were also injured. An FIR was lodged against 46 persons, including Jadeja.

The prosecution reasoned that the agitation was in the public interest and for the purpose of protection of interest of the local agriculturists and thereby

"withdrawal of such prosecution is in the larger public interest."

In October 2020, the prosecution had submitted an application before the magistrate court seeking withdrawal of prosecution against all 46 accused, including Jadeja.

The application was rejected by the court taking into account the seriousness of the offence and the "absence of independent application of mind" by the additional public prosecutor at the time. This is in light of the fact that the prosecutor had earlier in "no uncertain terms opined that the said case is not worth withdrawing."

The court of Justice Niral Mehta noted that despite the prosecutor's own negative opinion on the withdrawal of prosecution, "on the insistence of the higher authorities," the prosecution had sought withdrawal of prosecution before the magistrate court.
